Assessments and Analysis

Support comprehensive C-IED assessments of the nation's key resources and critical infrastructure, and collect, protect and share IED incident information and analysis with partners nationwide.



Capacity Building

Contribute directly to stakeholder infrastructure security, resilience capability and capacity enhancement. Enhance capabilities across the private and public sectors to assess and reduce vulnerabilities to critical infrastructure and mitigate bombing incidents.



Expertise and Guidance

Develop, lead and coordinate C-IED policy, strategies, guidance and standards to improve infrastructure security and resilience. Coordinate the provision of expertise and guidance with strategy and policy entities across DHS, CISA and the interagency.



Information Sharing

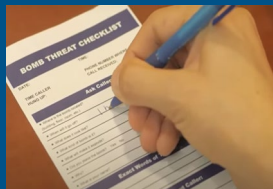
Build C-IED security and resilience through proactive collaboration and sharing of information with stakeholders to ensure the promulgation of well-targeted and useful best practices and standards.

Comprehensive assessments that provide a clear understanding of local C-IED capabilities and the opportunity to collaboratively establish a path to capability enhancement. Unit Level Assessments focus on first responder specialty units who respond to suspected IED incidents. Community Level Assessments incorporate in-person interviews with local private and public representatives and focuses on C-IED Key Functions.

[Explosive Blast Modeling](#)

Customized assessments to reinforce protective measures through visualized three-dimensional models. Depicts potential structural damage and bodily injury to inform mitigation plans.



[Interagency Policy Coordination](#)

OBP serves as the deputy administrator of the federal interagency Joint Program Office for countering IEDs, which coordinates and tracks federal government progress in building national C-IED capabilities and works in close collaboration with the White House National Security Council.
